BIOGRAPHY

Palmer E. Berger II, 63 , of Mapleton, ND and formerly of Grand Forks, ND died Wednesday, September 2, 2009 in Innovis Hospital, Fargo, ND.

Palmer Elton Berger II was born on November 8, 1945 the son of Palmer and Edna (Weir) Berger. He was the younger of two children. Palmer grew up and attended school in Grand Forks.
